

**WAFP Board of Directors – WAFP Resident and Alternate Resident Trustee
Application Deadline: Feb. 26, 2021**

Term: May 2020 – May 2021; one-year term.

Resident Trustee Position Responsibilities:

- Serve as the resident representative to the WAFP Board of Directors
- Attend all WAFP board meetings and serve on committees as indicated, representing resident interests.
- Report on activities from the Resident and Student Subcommittee.
- Co-lead a minimum of two meetings of the WAFP Resident and Student Subcommittee per year, held either by conference call or at the WAFP cluster meetings.
- Contribute an article quarterly to the *Washington Family Physician* journal.
- Maintain contact with Chief Residents at Washington residency programs and continue relations with the AAFP Resident leadership.
- Help coordinate budget spending and reimbursement from funding resources.
- Recruit or maintain relationships with residency network representatives.
- Connect fellow residents to serve as resident representatives on WAFP committees.
- Coordinate with the Student Co-Trustees to plan the annual WAFP Resident/Student Retreat. Attend the WAFP Annual Meeting, and organize resident delegation to the WAFP House of Delegates and National Congress of Family Medicine Residents (NCFMR).
- Announce and hold elections for Resident Trustee and serve as a resource for your successor.

WAFP Alternate Resident Trustee Position Responsibilities:

- Assist the Resident Trustee as requested with duties listed above.
- Plan to assume the role of Resident Trustee in the following year.

Selection Process for both Trustee positions:

- Candidate must have participated in one WAFP activity prior to being elected.
- Self-nominations accepted.
- Candidates must submit nomination materials, to include:
 - CV (two-page maximum);
 - One-page letter of interest; and
 - Letter of support from the residency program director(s).
- Nomination materials will be sent to all current WAFP resident members. Elections will be held in late January by electronic voting.
- Election results are sent to the WAFP House of Delegates for formal approval.
